Historical note:

The South East Asian Treaty Organization (SEATO) Cholera Research Laboratory was established in Bangkok, Thailand in December 1959 by an exchange of notes between the Governments of Thailand and the United States. The SEATO Medical Research Laboratory (SMRL) succeeded the Cholera Laboratory on 23 December 1960. A Clinical Research Center was added to the SMRL on 25 April 1963. The SMRL was composed of a Thai component and a U.S. component and was jointly staffed, with visiting scientists from other SEATO nations. The U.S. component was a special activity of the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research. The Army continued to work in cooperation with Thailand conducting medical research and training for the benefit of all. The Unit was renamed the Armed Forces Research Institute of Medical Sciences (AFRIMS) in 1977 when SEATO was disbanded. AFRIMS is still active.

Scope and content of the collection:

The SMRL records include correspondence, reports, unpublished reports, photocopies of agreements and Memorandums of Understanding, protocols and procedures, memorabilia, photographs, and negatives. The bulk of the material is the correspondence.

Original order was retained wherever possible. The bulk of the material was the correspondence and had been placed in folders in chronologic order. In years 1972-1975, telegrams were in separate folders, which are now interfiled with the appropriate year's correspondence. Some correspondence regarding the use and movement of gibbons had been separated from the other correspondence. This order has been maintained. Exact duplicates of any correspondence were removed and discarded. Most metal staples, paper clips and metal binders were removed. All records have been rehoused in acid-free folders.

A photocopy of the chapter Family muridae, rats and mice from the *Mammals of Thailand*, by and Jeffrey A McNeely, pages 395 to 490, published in 1977 was discarded as the book is readily available and there were no annotations. Materials were separated by document type and arranged chronologically. Most of the AV materials had been stored separately from the paper records. Many of the photographs and negatives were labeled and dated and were able to be matched to correspondence or reports for context, however there were some that could not be identified or dated.
