The WRAIR Association, Inc. was founded in 1982 by a group of present and past staff members of the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research. Membership is open to any and all persons interested in supporting the work of the largest and oldest medical research laboratory in the Department of Defense. Its aim is to support the research and teaching efforts of the Institute in various ways including scholarship and fellowship programs, as well as seminars and lectures.

This series includes the records regarding the establishment of the program and its ongoing running. Topics include membership, meeting minutes, and awards. The bulk of the correspondence is from Association Secretaries Paul Klein and Howard Noyes. This series also includes the photographs of the WRAIR Association ceremony in 1991 in which the Edward L. Buescher Young Scientist Award was presented to Richard Gordon and the Myron G. Radke Award was presented to H Kyle Webster. The records are arranged by type. The correspondence is arranged chronologically.
