(Propranolol, Hydrocortisone, or Morphine) or placebo

TO QUALIFY:

- ✓ Age 18 to 40
- ✓ Generally healthy
- ✓ Weigh 91-250 pounds
- ✓ Have fear of spiders
- ✓ Test negative for alcohol and drugs
- ✓ Men and women can participate, but women cannot be pregnant or
breast feeding
- ✓ If you are active duty military or federal personnel, must be on leave
